Frequently Asked Questions

Q. At Broulee do I have to pay any more fees at a later date after the burial takes place for maintenance or up keep?

A. No. Once the grave or plot is purchased there is no more to pay for maintenance or upkeep of that grave.

Q. How much more do I have to pay for a plaque? When do I have to pay for the plaque?

A. The fee for a 559 mm x 305 mm (22 x 12 inches) Bronze Burial Plaque with 7 lines of inscription is included in the interment fee, so as there is no more to pay once the funeral has taken place. The interment fee is paid prior to the day of the funeral.

Q. How much more do I have to pay for a Headstone? When do I have to pay for the Headstone?

A. The fee for a Basic Headstone with 40 Characters of painted inscription is paid at the time of need, usually a couple of days prior to funeral.

Q. Can I have more than 40 Characters of painted inscription on the Headstone?

A. In most cases Yes depending on the design of headstone that you choose, Extra characters are at an extra cost as are photos motifs and badges etc. The staff at Broulee Memorial Gardens will assist you with the headstone inscription etc and create a proof of the inscription for you to check prior to ordering.

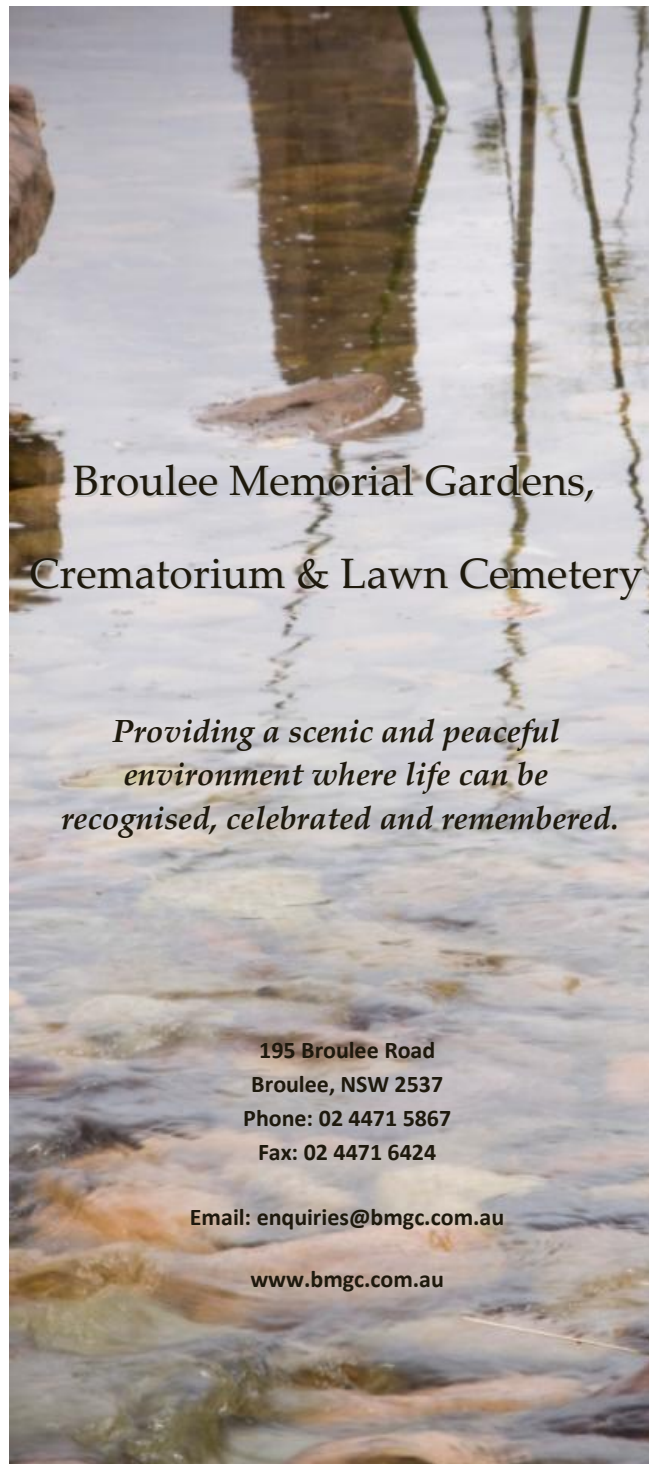
Q. Can I reserve a Grave or plot?

A. Yes. With a reservation or Pre Need Purchase you purchase the grave only (Right of Burial). That is you do not pay any interment fees until the Time of Need or the grave is used. There is a small fee for a reservation; which includes a reservation plaque identifying the site has been taken. Once a site has been reserved there is no more to pay for that site, even if for example its 10 or 15 years before the grave is used.

As Mentioned above the only fee that cannot be pre paid or reserved is the interment fees or plaque / monument fees these are payable at the time of need or use of the grave.

Q. Why is the plaque or headstone paid for at the time of need prior to the interment?

A. The reason for this is basically so no grave is ever left unmarked. If for whatever reason no one contacts us regarding the plaque or headstone wording/inscription Broulee Memorial Gardens reserve the right after 90 days to place a plaque or headstone in place stating the deceased name, year of birth, year of passing and age at passing.

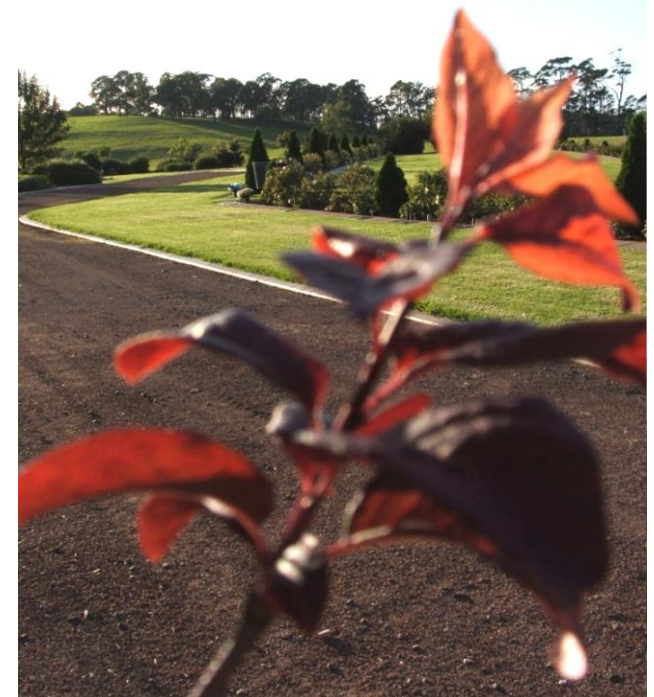

“Captain Oldrey” Section

In 1840, this area was included in a 4010 acre property granted to Captain William Oldrey, one of the first European settlers in the district. Known as Mt Oldrey Estate, his property was subsequently subdivided and sold.

Similar to the “Illawong” section of Lawn Graves the “Captain Oldrey” Section is also a flat beam section. The difference being graves are all marked with a Granite Headstone.

The Graves may be either single or double depth and are 3 metres long x 1½ metres wide.

An Exclusive Right of Burial (*Purchase of a Grave*) begins at \$2,200 for a Single Depth Burial right.

A basic headstone as shown below with 40 characters of painted inscription is included in the interment fees; extras such as more characters, different colours and shapes of headstones, photos and motifs are also available



The Captain Oldrey Monumental Lawn Section is in the middle of this photo adjacent to the Harry Panjer Rose Garden



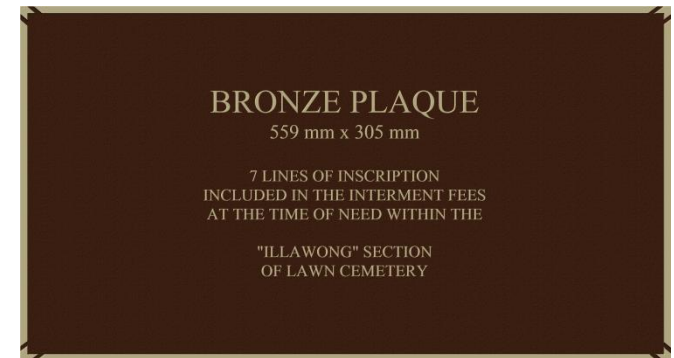
“Illawong” Section

As shown below the “Illawong” section of Lawn Graves is a flat beam section where by the graves are enhanced with 559 mm x 305 mm bronze plaques for that added personal touch.

The Graves may be either single or double depth and are 3 metres long x 1½ metres wide.

An Exclusive Right of Burial (*Purchase of a Grave*) begins at \$2,200 for a Single Depth Burial right.

A bronze plaque as shown below with 7 lines of inscription is included in the interment fees; extras such as more lines, different themes, photos and motifs are also available
